Praise the Lord we also had several guest viewers, who have been back every Sunday, one even from Germany and one from Hungary. How wonderful is that.

Family News: *Praise the Lord we are all well and not personally affected by the virus. My wife is getting stronger and dialysis helps her. My blood pressure is down to 140-150/90 and I'm feeling much better thank you for your prayers. The kids are well and finishing up their school year. Benjamin will graduate from high school this summer and will start Bible College in fall. Daniel has been home for Easter break and we were able to spend some time with him and thankfully we will get to keep Gabriela at home for a couple more years.*
