The wheels keep turning, the rivers keep flowing, and the winds keep blowing. Google gives me a monthly summary of where we have been, based on our navigation. I enjoy looking at it and am amazed at how God has kept us safe. I know that it is due to the prayers of His saints on our behalf.

I had the privilege and honor of preaching my father-in-law's funeral service, and it went well, though the time of mourning is not over. There are still times when we stop and get that far off look in our eyes while we think of him. Please continue to keep all of Donna's family in your prayers.

Since our last letter, five more churches have joined us in reaching the Samana region of the Dominican Republic: **Riverview Baptist Church** of Borger, TX, **Highland Missionary Baptist Church** of Dublin, TX, **Meadow Lakes Baptist Church** of Wasilla, AK, **Missionary Baptist Church** of Arkansas City, KS, and **Mountainview Baptist Church** of Ulysses, KS. We are excited to see progress towards the goal of being fully supported and able to leave for the Dominican Republic in January, though there is still a need for 19 more supporters, on average.

The surgery on Jonathan's clavicle went well and he is healing. There was more damage than what they saw on the x-rays, but they got him patched up nicely. He now shows even less desire to mountain bike with us. I believe his greatest pain is that there are many things he can't do yet and he has to be patient and heal.

As we covet your prayers, please understand it isn't a one-way street. Many pastors and supporting churches are hurting and we hold you up before God also. At least two of our supporting churches are without pastors right now. Other pastors are taking blows from the devil in their families and personal lives. Many families are affected by the fires in Oregon and Washington, as I write this. All of us have been affected by the Coronavirus and though we have not personally contracted it, we know many who have, and some who have lost loved ones.
