Dear Prayer Partners,

We trust this letter finds you well and resting in the grace of God. God is continuing to prove himself faithful, meeting our needs and blessing in His work here in South Africa. Thank you for all who continue to pray for us, your commitment to obey the Biblical command, “pray without ceasing” by regularly bringing our name before His throne of grace is a tremendous encouragement and help.

The Good. God has continued to allow us to meet and minister in the Word in Kwanobuhle. We have been blessed by the faithful attendance of several, and a few visitors. We have been especially blessed in recent months by the attendance of a Young lady who was introduced to the Gospel and Saved through the ministry of missionary Scott Kuzel. God in His great providence moved her to Kwanobuhle to stay with a relative a short time after He opened the door for us to begin having services. She has been saved for some time, but because of her family situation she has not lived in a place with a good church, two weeks ago she asked about Baptism, so Lord willing, we hope to plan a baptismal service soon. (This does pose a few difficulties, we don't have a baptistry, we are nearing winter so outside water sources are quite cold and due to the ongoing severe draught filling a baptistry even if we had one, could technically be illegal).

The Bad. My Bakkie (Pick-up) spent about three weeks in the garage (repair shop) the end of last month, beginning of this. Starting with the Oil Filter falling off as I was driving. Thankfully, it was just as I left home so the engine was not very warm, I was not going fast, and was able to get stopped quickly. Once it went in to the shop we went ahead and dealt with a number of issues that had been going on and getting worse for some time. The repairs ended up costly, but not terrible, the inconvenience of being down a vehicle for three weeks was the worst part, and the growing concern that the vehicle (a 2006 model) cannot be trusted as reliable is also a problem.

The Great. I met with a man this month who has completed the online Gospel study and a follow up discipleship course. He lives in a small town over 7hrs away and came just to meet with me. First, He brought his bro. in Law who lives in the area, and I was able to share a thorough gospel presentation with him. Second, he said that he would like to try and get a group together in his area If I would come and preach and teach to them!!! This would be a tremendous answer to prayer! Since I made a visit out to that part of the province a few years ago I have been burdened and have prayed for the Lord to open a door of utterance to minister in the Gospel in these more rural areas. Please pray that the Lord would open a door there in Mt. Frere, and from there into other parts of the Eastern Cape.

We are again, as always, grateful for your care of us. May God continue to bless you in His service.
