Hello! Praying that you are well and that the Lord is prospering your gospel endeavors. We are staying busy here. School has just started and we are still in the midst of trying to get our drivers licenses. There was confusion because we renewed our licenses right before we left the states and they thought that meant we had only been driving since March. Glad we had Mrs. Bell to help us navigate through that. Our paperwork has been resubmitted and we have to wait another 3-5 business days for processing. Then we take a cognitive test. We have one month to do this or we have to start again and take the Brazilian driving test.

We are trying to get some Bible studies going. Many have shown interest from the group that come to the Bell's house on Sunday for lunch. The Bell family started this community lunch in the middle of the pandemic to help those on the street and to have an opportunity to share the gospel with them. This has grown from their table to about 50-80 every week. It is hard to talk to everyone but every week Chris and Brenda, since they are most fluent, sit and talk with a few. Along the way people have shown up with Bibles and others just ask if we have anything else going on. Trying to get them together on a separate day is proving difficult we would ask that you pray with us in this regard.

We ask that you pray for us as we move forward with building relationships with these people and for clear direction with the meal on Sundays. The traffic the lunch has created is something we are going to have to work out. The neighbors are not comfortable with the large groups hanging out in front of their houses as they wait for lunch. Please continue to pray for us as we build a web page and make tracts to print. I would also ask that you pray for my Portuguese teacher as we try and disciple him. He is going through a lot right now. School has changed out schedules somewhat, but Amanda continues to have language lessons twice a week with Brenda. As always, we would ask that you pray for our language acquisition, and our family as we settle in.
