**Brethren,**

Hello from Belém! I hope you are all well. Things here are progressing. I want to start off by praising the Lord that we have our drivers licences! We pushed the time limit but got it done and without any more hangups. Brenda Bell was a tremendous help with the paperwork and with talking with everyone we had to deal with. Now we need to find a vehicle suited for our family and the roads here. In September I also had the opportunity to fill the pulpit in Aninaneuea. I am still learning Portuguese so Brother Kyron translated for me. You all know this was not a small task. I am looking forward to not needing any help in that area in the future.

The Sunday meal at the Bell's continues to bring in many people and we are continuing to get bible studies going. With that in mind and much prayer and deliberation, we have decided to pull back the meals to once a month. This is to free up more time to get out to the local parks to pass out tracks and to invite people to have a bible study. Brazilians tend to have the main service at night on Sundays. So local parks are extremely busy, in general, on Sundays. We would ask that you pray along with us as we get out and talk with people. Our hope is three fold. We can continue to build relationships with those that the meal brings, cast a wider net in going out to the parks, and improve our Portuguese by talking to more people.

On November 2<sup>nd</sup>, I received word that my father died in a car wreck. I waited to send out this prayer letter to figure out when I'll fly home but that hasn't been determined. My sisters are handling all the details and haven't settled on a date for the memorial. Although we didn't have much contact with him, our hope is that we might be able to share the gospel with my family in Mexico during this time and at the memorial. I would appreciate your prayers for my family. Our other prayer requests remain the same. Our language acquisition, our kids school, and most of all that Brazilians would be saved.
