Teaching Opportunities

This year began with plans for more classes and helping with other training programs around the world. Our college level teaching in Spanish is growing. The spring semester of our online Theology class found me teaching Ecclesiology (the doctrine of the Church). I have over 20 students studying online in Chile, Argentina, Peru, Honduras, Mexico, and the U.S.A. We started our online live teaching several years before the COVID pandemic and, now, it continues to grow. We are hoping to confer some Bachelor's degrees this next year in Mexico and Peru. Our school is grateful for the help of other teachers, such as my brother-in-law, David Lott, and his son, Jonathan Lott.

I am also teaching in our English college and taught a modular class on Evangelism in Missions. In April, I had the privilege of teaching a modular class on Principles of Bi-

ble Translation at Masters College in Fargo, North Dakota. While I was in Fargo, I recorded an internet class on The Life of Christ with Missionary Jeff Lange for his new online Bible Institute.

In May, I will be travelling to Mexico to teach at a preacher's con-

ference in the state of Chiapas. Also in May, I will be teaching in our Spanish online college a Theology course on Angiology and then in July a course on Eschatology (Future events). So, as you can see, I keep a full teaching schedule.
