She is from a Muslim background and her husband prohibits her from coming to church, and physically persecutes her for her faith.

Continue to pray for the ministry with the young men of the orphanage. Brother Adham is spending much of his time working with these young men. Pray the Lord would give him patience and wisdom in helping these young men, as well as providing for his own needs. We were able to expand the ministry to some other young men coming from similarly abused and neglectful backgrounds. We would love to see these young men remember the Creator in the days of their youth.

Pray for the growth and stability of the young church. The members have an honest and simple love for the Word of God that is encouraging. There are many hurdles and "fiery darts" to be defended against, and much work to be done in the Word and in their lives, but God is faithful. We praise Him for the work He has done and await the work He will do.
