Our kiddos have finished the school year and we have again decided to have them do some Portuguese lessons with my teacher Jonas through the summer. My mother has also volunteered to hand deliver the school material and plans on flying down at the end of July. June is the month the Bells go home for furlough so this will definitely be a growing season for us in our Portuguese usage. As always, we ask you to pray for us in this area but above all that people would be saved.
